

Facts **What does Johnson Mortgage Company, LLC do with your personal information?**

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and transaction history (with us, affiliates, or others)
- Credit history and payment history

How? All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons Johnson Mortgage Company, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	This notice is being provided by Johnson Mortgage Company, LLC.
What we do	
How does Johnson Mortgage Company, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Our employees are bound by our Code of Business Conduct and Ethics and policies when accessing your personal information.
How does Johnson Mortgage Company, LLC collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an account or deposit money ▪ Apply for a loan or pay your bills ▪ Use your credit card or debit card We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law*.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>Our affiliates include companies with a Virginia Partners Bank/Maryland Partners Bank name.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies. <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include government entities, credit bureaus, software developers, service providers, companies that provide marketing services on our behalf, and consulting firms.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>Our joint marketing partners include financial product or service companies that may provide products or services not offered by us.</i>
Other important information	
*You may have other privacy protections under some state laws. We will comply with all applicable state laws as to information about you, including medical information.
